## AUDITION PROCESS

Auditionees will be taken through a short choreography piece that will be taught on the day. Do not stress if you are not a “dancer”, there are plenty of roles for strong singers and actors too! Please wear activewear that is easy to move in, along with sneakers or jazz shoes.

After this, all auditionees will be asked to sing a short excerpt from the show as a small group and then individually. It is not compulsory that you sing individually but please note - **Those wanting to be considered for named character roles MUST sing individually.**

## CALL BACKS

**Call Backs will be on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> May from 4.30pm-7.30pm. Please keep the whole afternoon/evening free.**

For call backs, please prepare the relevant material for the character you wish to audition for. The purpose of this is not to see how well you learn lines but to see your characterisation shine! Call backs will be given to those we are considering for lead roles. If you do not get a call back, this doesn't mean that you are not being considered for the show.

Please note, you may be called back for a role that is not on your wish list if the audition panel sees potential for other roles, so please familiarise yourself with as many songs as possible.
